#### Instructions

- Once the clear coating has been applied to the satisfaction of the painter, apply a light mist coat of Lacquer Repair Spray over the blend area holding the aerosol at 25cm from the panel.
- The blending process is best undertaken in two rapid, light passes of the aerosol
- The blend edge will melt into the original paintwork and requires little or no processing once the clear coating has cured
- After application follow the clear coating manufacturer's instructions for flash off and air/force dry.
