Good for use in combination with water based paints.

Instructions

- Ensure surfaces to be masked are clean and free of dust.
- Apply tape to area to be masked following the contours required.
- Apply pressure to the surface of the tape on bends and corners to ensure product remains flat.
- Mask the remainder of the area
- Paint the vehicle.
- Once the paint is dry remove all the masking materials.
- Once the tape is removed, inspect the edges and polish if necessary.
